Garryowen and Old Crescent thrilled a large crowd at Thomond Park on Sunday last with their display in atrocious conditions, and one imagines that all were pleased with the 6-all draw.

To-morrow, there should be a huge crowd present for the re-play between the sides, and with the strong sun blazing in the window as I write, the stage seems to be set for a thrilling 80 minutes of Munster Cup football.

At the same time, Young Munster will be doing battle in their postponed tie at Musgrave Park against Dolphin. The longer period of training will have benefited both sides immensely and the standard of play to-morrow should be much higher than in the first meeting of the teams.

Garryowen announced their side last evening and it shows one change. As expected, Tom Coffey (three times captain of the club) is recalled, and he replaces John O'Dwyer in the front row. Old Crescent are further deliberating over the selection of their XV. Jim Riordan, who was unable to play last week, hopes to be fit in time, but he will undergo a rigorous fitness test later to-day. If available it seems likely that the former Munster interprovincial, who has played in every position behind the scrum (except scrum-half in the Cup for Old Crescent) will come back, and this would mean the dropping of probably one.....

Hold sway in the set scrums, while the lively back-row of Fin, Harrington, Henry Wall and Mick O'Leary could prove too lively. Nevertheless, Young Munster's great fighting spirit and Cup tradition, could also see them to the fore in the loose, where Paddy Wallace, Joe Casey and so will take stopping.

However, Dolphin look slightly the more authoritative XV, and one appreciates that one kindly bounce of the ball could be sufficient to give a pleasing

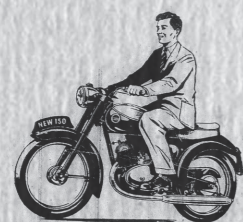
